**1. Organizing Authority**

The organizing authority is the Sarasota Sailing Squadron

**2. Rules**

This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), and applicable One Design Class Rules.

**3. Eligibility**

The regatta is open to all one design classes with five or more entries. Expected classes include S2 7.9, E Scows, MC Scows, Albacore, Daysailer, VX One, and Windmill.

**4. Registration & Fees**

- 4.1. \$85 per boat; includes 2 Friday dinners, 2 Saturday dinners and 1 T-shirt.
- 4.2. \$50 Bare Bones registration; No Dinner No Shirt
- 4.3. \$20 Late Fee for paid registrations received after March 1, 2013 at 6pm EST.
- 4.4. Extra dinner tickets \$15; Extra T-Shirts \$15 will be available online and onsite during registration.

- 845 Registration & Check-In opens
  - 1000 Registration & Check-In close
  - 1030 Skippers Meeting
  - 1130 Warning Signal first race of the day for all classes
- Dinner to follow racing

**Sunday, March 24, 2013**

- 1000 Warning Signal first race of the day for all classes
- No race to start after 1330

Award presentation as soon as possible after racing

**6. Sailing Instructions**

Sailing Instructions and Courses will be available at Registration.

**7. Race Area**

Racing will be in Sarasota Bay.

**8. Scoring**

- 8.1. When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. This changes RRS A2.
- 8.2. One race will constitute a regatta.

**9. Prizes**

Awards will be given out according to the number of registrants in each class.

**10. Disclaimer of Liability**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**11. Parking**

Parking is available for trailers and cars outside the main entrance. Vehicles parked blocking SSS members' boats will be towed.

**12. Accommodations**
