Sailing Venue – Tahoe City, CA

Offering the most consistent winds on the west shore, Tahoe City is a great venue for sailboat racing. The Coast Guard ramp has great launching facilities close to the racecourse.

Skiing Venue – Alpine Meadow

This mountain offers seven open bowls, gentle, top-to-bottom cruisers, and forested glades. Alpine Meadows attracts skiers and riders who are passionate about their turns, but offers something for everyone.

Format

Regatta Score plus Ski Race placement determines the winner.

Skiing Rules

V-15 and Laser: Every sailor gets four runs and his or her top three times will be counted.
