Bring your own sandwiches, beer provided by Mission Yacht Club. **Please watch out for the team racing event** being held in the cove.

# The Course:

A temporary orange buoy and committee boat will mark the start and finish line.

A practice start will be ended by signaling a general recall.

Racing will be a windward leeward course with all marks rounded to port. The windward mark will be a temporary orange buoy. The leeward mark will be a large green buoy or a temporary orange buoy, to be determined by the RC. RC will determine either once or twice around.

**Sailing Instructions and Notices:** All communications and changes shall be verbal both by vhf radio on channel 65 (or other channel as announced by RC) and by loud hailer.

Starts: The sound system (5 minute, appendix Q) shall be used.

### **Emeryville Flats info:**

Expect good wind with puffs and very mild chop. There will be a gradient of current running across the course.
