Santana 22 National Championship Regatta July 19th, 20th, & 21st, 2019 NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1. The race will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 2. RRS 40 is changed but not its prescription and replaced with: "Competitors shall wear US Coast Guard approved personal flotation devices at all times while afloat, except briefly while changing clothing or personal equipment."
- 3. The sailing instructions will change RRS 44 to require a one turn penalty.

2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 1. The regatta is open to all Santana 22 Class sailboats that conform with the class rules. The boat's skipper must be a current member (2019) of the Santana 22 class associations.
- 2. FEES: The entry fee is \$140 per boat on or before July 19, 2019. Fee includes all racing and 1 dinner ticket per boat (for one person) Saturday night immediately following the fleet meeting.
- 3. Competitors shall register in advance by completing the Event Registration Form found on http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/19163. The entry will be considered complete when the form is submitted and the entry fees are paid in full.

3. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS: Racing and Social

Friday July 19th:

- 1. 10am Registration & check-in.
- 2. 2pm Optional Practice Races 2pm First Warning (short courses). Two races scheduled.

Saturday July 20th:

- 1. 11:55am First Warning; Three races scheduled with a short break in between.
- 2. 6:00pm Class meeting.
- 3. 6:30pm Dinner (dinners for the rest of the crew can be purchased when registering)

Sunday July 21st:

- 1. 11:55am First Warning; Two races scheduled with a short break in between.
- 2. Awards presentation after racing.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

Sailing instructions will be available at http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/19163 no later than July 18th. A limited number of sailing instructions (hardcopies) will be available at RYC prior to racing.

5. COURSES AND LOCATION:

- 1. Races shall be sailed in San Francisco Bay.
- 2. The start and finish line will be located 3/4 mile southeast of the Richmond Potrero breakwater entrance with the intent of sailing in more moderate conditions partly to leeward of Angel Island. Courses will be windward leeward, using inflatable temporary marks.

6. COMMUNICATIONS:

The Race Committee may use the VHF 71 radio to communicate information about time to start and recalls.

7. SCORING:

A maximum of 5 races are scheduled of which 3 shall be completed to constitute a series. There are no throw outs for this series (this changes A2: Series Scores). Friday's practice races will not be scored.

8. SAFETY:

A boat retiring from a race shall notify the Race Committee before leaving the course by VHF, or as soon as reasonably possible thereafter.

9. PRIZES:

Keeper Trophies first through fifth place and Class Perpetual Trophies will be awarded.

10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority or the RYC will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

11. INSURANCE:

Each participating boat shall be insured with a valid third-party liability insurance policy.

12. LAUNCHING:

After a boat launches it shall stay in the water until the end of the event.

13. DOCKING & PARKING (the following is not part of the NOR)

- 1. Participants are invited to use RYC's guest dock and raft up in the turning basin just east of the clubhouse. If you wish to extend your stay to the day before and/or the day after, you must coordinate with the Harbormaster.
- 2. Overnighting aboard your boat is possible. Club shower/bath facilities are available.
- 3. Richmond also has parking for campers, vehicles and trailers.
